Plenary 1: "Who is Serving on the Picket Line for the Miracle of Life?"

Ron Banks is the Director, Division of Comparative Medicine for the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences here in Oklahoma City. He received his veterinary training from Auburn University College of Veterinary Medicine after which he entered military service in the U.S. Army Veterinary Corps. His research medicine residency at Walter Reed Army Institute of Research in Washington DC was followed by several assignments supporting research seeking improved survivability for the soldier, sailor, airman or marine. Dr. Banks joined the OUHSC program in 2016 after serving for over a decade as the Director, Office of Animal Welfare for Duke University and Duke University Medical Center.



Plenary 2: "New Routes on an Information Journey: Preparing for Crucial Conversations®"

Valerie N. Williams, Ph.D., is Vice Provost for Academic Affairs and Faculty Development at the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center. In this role she has responsibility for campus-wide academic affairs, academic integrity and faculty development issues. A year after joining the OUHSC College of Medicine faculty in 1989, Dr. Williams created the Health Sciences Center Faculty Leadership Program, an interprofessional faculty development and mentoring program. As program director Dr. Williams has served as a mentor or coach for over 350 OUHSC faculty and over 500 faculty participating in summer institutes or nationally sponsored faculty development programs.

Ted Streuli is the President and Executive Director of Peaceful Family Solutions, an organization that provides free therapy to children whose parents suffer from addiction. In addition to a 30-year career in journalism, he has worked as a professional square dance caller, an ice hockey referee, and a circus clown.
